
QUICK REFERENCE TOOL FOR REPORTING SERIOUS ADVERSE EVENTS (SAEs) / UNANTICIPATED PROBLEMS (UPs) TO THE Network REB

Network (LOCAL) SAEs/ Unanticipated Problems (UPs):


Report if serious AND unexpected AND related or possibly related to the research.

<u>Note</u>: Follow the study protocol, Sponsor's study specific SOPs, REB study specific requirements and regulatory authority requirements (as applicable)



EXTERNAL SAEs/ Unanticipated Problems (UPs):

Report if serious <u>AND</u> unexpected <u>AND</u> related or possibly related to the research <u>AND</u> requires a change to the research or notification to research participants



PERIODIC SAFETY UPDATE REPORT (PSUR): Submit a summary of all suspected unexpected SAEs that have occurred in the reporting period in **table format** using the 'Network REB Updated Safety Information Reporting Form'
